No child be allowed to participate in the Street Art Workshop prior to receipt of the completed and signed release form.

Conditions:

- Participation in this workshop is solely at the risk and liability of the parent or legal guardian enrolling the child.
- It is the responsibility of the registering parent or guardian to ensure the proper placement of the child with regard to the child's skill level. Noosa Junction Association and its employees/contractors cannot accept liability for any injury or damages that you or your child may suffer related to participation in activities sponsored by Noosa Junction Association.
- Every effort will be made by Noosa Junction Association and its employees/contractors to ensure the safety of your child during the Workshop. Parents/Guardians will be called should the student become upset or disruptive during the workshop.
- If an emergency or illness occurs while your child is at the Street Art Workshop and staff consider the situation to be life threatening or otherwise potentially hazardous to your child, your child's health, other children or any property, staff may escort the child from the workshop. Staff may at that time request any personal or professional assistance that is deemed necessary to protect the welfare of the child.
- Noosa Junction Association staff will not administer any medication to any child. If the child has a pre-existing condition requiring or a need for prescribed medication, please ensure that the parent or guardian is able to satisfy these needs either prior to or after the day's session..
- Please make arrangements to arrive 10 minutes prior to the start of class, and to retrieve your child no later than the scheduled end of class. Parents are advised to take children to the bathroom before the workshop begins.
- Any personal belongings of the enrolled child or the parent/guardian that enters the premises of Noosa Junction Association remain the sole responsibility of the child, parent, or guardian. Noosa Junction Association shall not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property or belongings
